FRENCH CALL FOR BAN ON CHANNEL SWIMMING

Armed with little more than a bathing suit, nose plugs and a liberal 0 of Vaseline, hundreds of cross-Channel swimmers have 1 out one of sport's toughest challenge since Captain Matthew Webb first 2 in the task in 1875.

More than 1,200 hardy souls have journeyed from all over the world to make the 21-mile crossing between Dover and Cap Gris Nez, near Calais, braving exhaustion, chafing and 100,000-ton container ships in order to achieve their dream. Many more have failed.

Now growing 3 over safety and fears of rising numbers 4 up the challenge has led some to 5 for stricter rules on cross- Channel swimming. A coalition of ferry operators urged greater regulation of swimming in the world's busiest shipping lane claiming that there has been an explosion in the number of people attempting to swim.

But representatives of the sport say numbers have not 6 up and that the swim is already highly regulated. Michael Oram, the honorary secretary of the Channel Swimming and Piloting Federation who has been piloting swimmers for the past 30 years, said 7 measures were already highly effective.

Mr Oram said: "We are one of the safest extreme endurance sports. There have been four deaths with the official swims since 1875 and these were heart attacks and problems like that. In 1953 one man couldn't 8 an escort boat and towed a rubber ring behind him and was never seen again. You can get four deaths in the London Marathon or 11-15 a year on Everest." He said the number of people crossing was already controlled by a voluntary agreement 9 the number of swimmers and escort boats operated by the two cross-Channel swimming associations. All swimmers must 10 the rule, and the number of crossings had remained static for the past four years.

BELGIAN HORSEBACK SHRIMPERS VOW TO PRESERVE TRADE

Belgium's horseback shrimp fishery must be 0 of the most out-dated trades in the world. Men in bright yellow overalls and jackets ride 11 own workhorses across the sands into the North Sea 12 low tide, searching for shrimps in just the way their forefathers 13 more than 500 years ago. Today there are 14 more than about a dozen fishermen left of the hundreds 15 once practiced the same trade all around the North Sea - in France, the Netherlands and Britain.

Just as in 1500, the horses drag two large planks behind them that open out once in the water to reveal a net that scoops up the shrimps and any other fish lurking in the surf. 500 years ago coastal farmers mainly used the shrimps and fish as fertilizer for their fields. The catch is now 16 likely to end up on a plate than a field, but prices are nowhere near enough for the fishermen to make a profit. However, 17 the old tradition attracts a lot of tourists, the tourist board in the small coastal town of Oostduinkerke decided to support the last outpost of the trade.

"We are as a commune very proud 18 our fishermen," said Christiane Moncarey from the tourist board. "We try to help them in 19 way we can. There are still men who like this type of horse riding and fishing. It's a passion for many of 20 . There is such a love story between the horse and the fisherman. Sometimes we say we like our horses more than our wife."

HOW ONE YOUNG ENTREPRENEUR TURNED HIS DYSLEXIA INTO A BUSINESS

Gary Smith (0) his dyslexia into an asset. With the help of his mentor, he founded Brainbook, a company specialising in health and educational software.

Through Brainbook, 24-year-old Gary released the Dyslexia Toolbox app, designed to aid the dyslexic - such as the order of letters in a word or months in the year, date formats as well as differentiating (29) left and right.

As the type of dyslexia varies (30) one person to another, the Dyslexia Toolbox app can be modelled to each user's individual needs rather than taking a one size fits all approach.

"From the start to (31) I am now has involved a lot of paperwork and a lot of document preparation," he explains. "It is a very common difficulty within dyslexia that we would find it really difficult to start a document and write it but spoken word will be extremely articulated."

"I am not one to hesitate or be scared to do what I want to do, probably because I've worked (32) all my life and overcome health conditions, but I can see why someone with dyslexia would avoid starting a business at all costs."

Half of dyslexics experience Irlen Syndrome, which prevents many people from reading effectively and efficiently. Yet, Gary says, nobody makes changes to their systems to accommodate.

"This is (33) I'm building the technology to cater and provide to them so they don't have to make the changes, we do. My best advice I can give is this: Everybody who walks this planet has difficulties, never be afraid to (34) someone for help so you can understand and get better."
